

Accessible Parking Permits

- Accessible parking permits for residents are available at no charge from the Town Clerk's Office. In order to apply for a permit, you and your doctor must complete an [Application for a Parking Permit for Persons with Severe Disabilities \(PDF\)](#).
- Residents of the Village of Canisteo will need to obtain Accessible Parking Permit from the Village of Canisteo, 8 Green Street, Canisteo, NY 14823

- a. You must also bring the driver's license of the person to whom the permit was issued, unless that person does not have a driver's license.
- b. Upon receipt of the application, the Town Clerk will issue a Temporary or Permanent Parking Permit.
 - a. A Temporary Parking Permit can be issued for up to 6 months, at the discretion of the doctor.
 - b. A Permanent Parking Permit is issued for a five-year period. At the end of five years, the parking permit may be renewed at the Town Clerk's Office, provided that permit holder still resides in the town of Canisteo.
- c. Important Information:
 - i. The Accessible Parking Permit is issued to the person with the disability, not to the vehicle.
 - ii. Persons other than to whom the permit is issued may not use the permit unless they are transporting the person to whom the permit is issued.
 - iii. Accessible Parking Permits should not be left on the rear-view mirror when driving.
 - iv. Lost or Stolen permits should be reported to the issuing agency immediately.
 - v. Permits are issued by the municipality in which you reside.
